Dear RI AGO Members,

I want to share with you exciting news about a wonderful donation by a friend and the family of the late Lois Conboy, a longtime member of RIAGO. \$4500 has been donated to our Chapter to promote the study of the organ. REMEMBERING LOIS CONBOY

The Reverend Thomas Conboy, Ir., in an email to Doris Alberg accompanying his donation to memorialize his wife, Lois, shared some details of her life and work:

Lois started taking organ lessons in Junior High School. She attended Westminster College Choir School in Princeton, New Jersey, focusing on Organ and Choir/Choral directing. Her education was interrupted by our marriage and completed by her graduation with a degree in Education from California State University (PA) and a later MEd.

We moved to RI in 1972 when I became Pastor of the Calvin Presbyterian Church in Cumberland. Lois oversaw the selection and installation of the new organ in our newly constructed church. She served as volunteer Organist/Choir Director at Calvin for over fifteen years and during those years spent every one of her "vacation Sundays" playing at other churches. After retiring from Calvin, Lois served as interim, and in her last years in RI served as Organist/Choir Director of the Community Church of Providence.

Lois loved the RIAGO. She was active in workshops and conventions. But most of all, she enjoyed and cherished the friendship and fellowship of you Guild members.
