How to Apply for your Audition

- 1) Write a short statement on why you want to learn to play the organ.
- 2) Ask your piano teacher to write a recommendation for you.
- 3) Fill out the application form below (make a copy to keep for yourself).
- 4) Send your statement, your teacher's recommendation, and your application, along with a \$5 application fee to: Nancy Nicholson, 90 12th St., Providence, RI 02906 (phone: 401 521-9097). Make your check payable to RIAGO.

We will call you to schedule an audition. It will be informal, with your teacher attending, and will last about 45 minutes.

Note: If accepted into the Introduction to the Organ Program, you must begin your organ lessons within 30 days of receiving the scholarship and complete them within 6 months. RIAGO will help students find an organ for their practice.

What to prepare for your Audition

- 1) Two short piano solos in contrasting styles (memorization optional).
- 2) A technique sequence, for example, a major scale, or a harmonic minor scale, or short study for piano.
- 3) Be ready to sight read a short piece.
